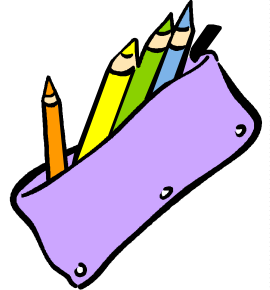

### "RECIPE FOR DISCIPLESHIP"

(From a sermon delivered by Rev. Dr. Bertrice Y. Wood, July 18, 2010, Solon Community Church)

#### INGREDIENTS

1. Main Ingredient: Word of God. Feast on the Word of God. Avoid distractions by unnecessary details.
2. Learn from Jesus' teachings and actions: Be sure that you seek to understand the meaning of Jesus' ministry for today.
3. Measure of Freedom: Let go of the expectations, stereotypes, things of the past that will slow down and limit the taste of your meal for discipleship.
4. Measure of Time and Focus: Push distractions aside and focus on what God is calling you to do.
5. Measure of Wisdom: Discern what's important. Hear and savor the Word of God.
6. Measure of Balance: Be sure that knowing and doing are in balance. Allow time for love, renewal of your spirit, reconnecting with God's Word as fresh news each day.
7. Dash of "this and that": Give your discipleship those special ingredients that will reflect who you are and what you can offer to the building of God's Kingdom.

#### *Remember:*

- "Presentation, Presentation, Presentation." Be a disciple who remains rooted in a conviction of faith, love. Garnishings should include peace and justice, welcoming attitude for all who might seek to join you and your church on the path to discipleship, humility, and trust in God.
- Savor the opportunity to put learning into acts.
- Enjoy the lasting pleasant taste.
